HOW WE STARTED

- The **Model N, R, S** organization was first formed in 1998 by a small group of antique car owners who wanted to share an interest in early Ford cars made in the period 1906 to 1909. Bruce Hartel was the principal founder.
- The organization became a Chapter of the Model T Club of America in 2000 and a Registry of The Horseless Carriage Club of America in 2004.
- In 2004 the club changed its name to the **1903-1909 Early Ford Registry** and expanded its coverage to include all early Ford cars made in the period 1903 to 1909. Contact was made with Carlton Pate and his 1903-1905 Ford 2-Cylinder group who had similar goals.
- In April 2005, an Internet website was created to improve the communication and information available to its members. The website activity was more than 1,100 per month at the end of 2007. Current world-wide membership is in excess of 130 members.
- On February 7, 2007, the Early Ford Registry became incorporated in the state of Iowa and on August 3, 2007 became classified by the IRS as a nonprofit organization (501C-3 classification) effective February 7, 2007. The official name is now **The 1903-1909 Early Ford Registry, Inc.** The organization is structured with a 9 person volunteer Board of Directors. The board members have three year terms. Three members of the Board are elected by the members each year. The Officers, (President, Vice-President and Secretary-Treasurer) are elected by the Board annually.
- Several regional meetings have been held each year around the country to enable members to meet and exchange ideas – Chickasha Swap meet in Oklahoma, Bakersfield Swap meet in California, and Hershey Car Show and Swap meet in Pennsylvania.
