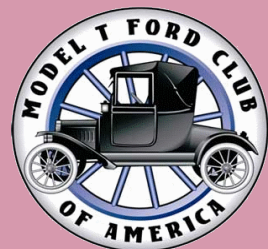

- Paul Schaeffer - Ohio

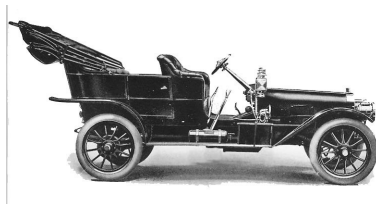
The new Board of Directors has convened and elected Officers for 2009. The incumbents all desired to continue another term in their present office. We had no one on the Board desiring to challenge.
