#### **Year End Elections are approaching.**

This is the place where you can look at and download **Technical Drawings**. From time to time new reprints of old magazine articles are added to this area.

We assign your Login when we accept your registration and annual dues. Your Login is a combination of your last name (in lower case with no spaces) and your EFR Member Number. For Example: **Ima A. McDonald Jr.** with Early Ford Registry member number **23** would be **mcdonald23**.

Every Newsletter, from day one, is in the Members Area in pdf format – (Portable Document Format).

#### *The Users Form of the EFR Website*

The Users Forum is a completely separate program and you must register to make a posting on it. Anyone may read the postings but to make a posting, you must be registered.
