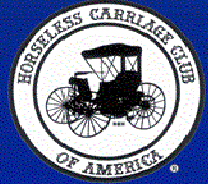

New Additions to Members Area Catalogs

We are very fortunate that our members are willing to share their history with us. **Tim Morsher, EFR 126**, has contributed many articles and old printed history with us in the past. He also has contributed to our award winning newsletter.

He recently shared four rare catalogs with us. They are from the turn of the 20th Century. You can purchase and print them by logging into the *Members Area* on the EFR website, www.EarlyFordRegistry.com.

The first catalog we scanned and uploaded is from **The Automobile Buyers Association** from 1906 and 1907. It's "Everything and Every Make for the Automobile", a 60 page document. They were located at 98 Chambers Street, New York City, New York. Tim's copy of this book is in very good condition so the scanned copy is very easy to read.

The second catalog we scanned was from **Collister & Sayle** with two stores in Cleveland, Ohio. It is a 160 page book of excellent quality. The title "Motor Car and Bicycle Supplies" tells it all. The tools, parts and chemicals are extremely interesting.

The third catalog we are scanning (still in progress), is a 221 page Parts List from **Jos. Strauss & Son** in Buffalo, New York. It is dated for all makes from 1908 thru 1917 and has parts and tools for autos, motorcycles and bicycles. It has parts for the famous **Excelsior** motorcycle.

The last catalog (still in progress) is from Excelsior Supply Company, 233-237 Randolph Street, Chicago, Illinois. This company was established in 1876. It is 154 pages of fair quality. There are hundreds of parts and tools pictured and described.

If you only see the first two catalogs when you check, we'll have the others posted real soon now.
