Important Dates to Remember

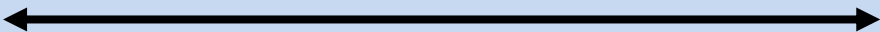

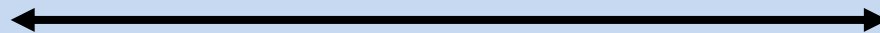
