

August 9-12, 2017, New London to New Brighton 31st Annual Antique Car Run. Pre-tours: Tuesday, August 9 through Friday, August 11 headquartered in New London, Minnesota. Starting in New London early in the morning, the drive is about 120 miles with several coffee breaks and lunch.
