A Christmas Report from the Restoration Committee

Been up in Ann Arbor at Dan and Sue Walters spending some time on the Model "N" project for the Early Ford Club. Paul Schaefer came over and helped also. Yesterday we drilled, riveted, and installed the fender after "adjusting" the fender brackets. Today we installed the timer, set the front alignment, bent and pinned the wishbone to give correct toe in, cleaned and installed new Kevlar bands on the transmission linings, and put a new bushing and rear babbitt bearing in the transmission housing. Tomorrow we are planning to pull the engine



and install the transmission.

Have to do that by noon, because by early afternoon I have to be at the Piquette Ford plant to pick up the 1903 Ford body I will be taking to the restoration shop on Monday. Want to spend a day checking out the work and then head home next Wed.

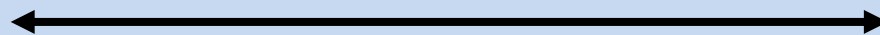
