Important Fire Extinguisher Recall

Just received information from our **President, Bruce Van Sloun**, about a recall of **Kidde Fire Products**. The recall involves two styles of disposable fire extinguishers: **Plastic handle fire extinguishers** and **Plastic push-button fire extinguishers**. The Recall **does not** include units with metal handles or valve assemblies. View the following links to determine if you have an affected model:

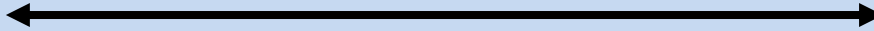

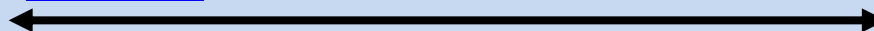
