<p><b>1. How do I Login if I forgot my Password?</b></p> 	<p><b>2. Enter your Username and your best guess of a Password. If the guess is incorrect, this screen will be displayed. Click on the "I forgot my Password".</b></p> 
<p><b>3. Enter your Username and E-mail address. Then click submit.</b></p> 	<p><b>4. This message will be displayed. Check your E-mail for a message with a new password. You <u>must</u> click on the link in the E-mail to activate the password.</b></p>
