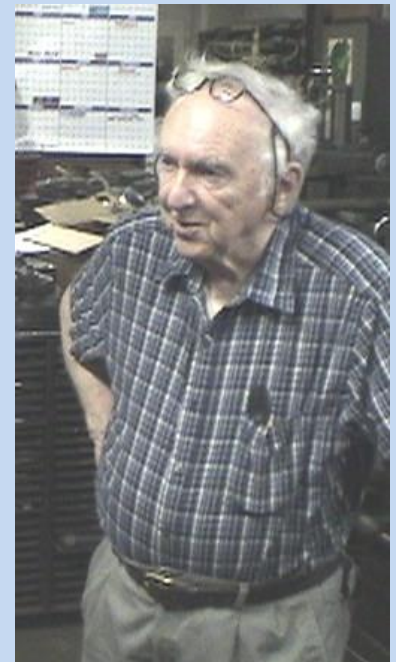
Eugene Kristoffy Memorial Library

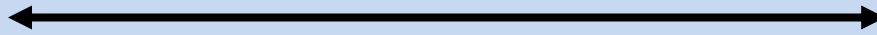
