## *Eugene Kristoffy Drawings in Library*

We have 137 large drawings scanned, catalogued and available in our **Gene Kristoffy Memorial Section of the EFR Library**. The professional company scanning the drawings was **Rapids Reproductions** in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. They have previously scanned such famous paintings as Grant Wood's work to determine what library to display it in. Our scans turned out very readable, in fact much better than the originals.

We have organized Kristoffy's work in two sections. The first section is photographs, notes and letters. Final cataloging of it will be done in a couple of weeks. The second section is the large drawings. It is organized by Ford model number with a couple of extra sections. Section "H" is many drawings of Holley carburetors. There are two other sections, "O" is for other drawings. Drawings from Cadillac carburetor and others. The final section are Unidentified drawings called "U" section. Many of these just have not been identified. The cataloging is expected to be revised as drawings are better identified.

Depending on your browser, you might have to login to the Library before these pages will be displayed. Your login to the Library is your last name in lower case and EFR number – no space.

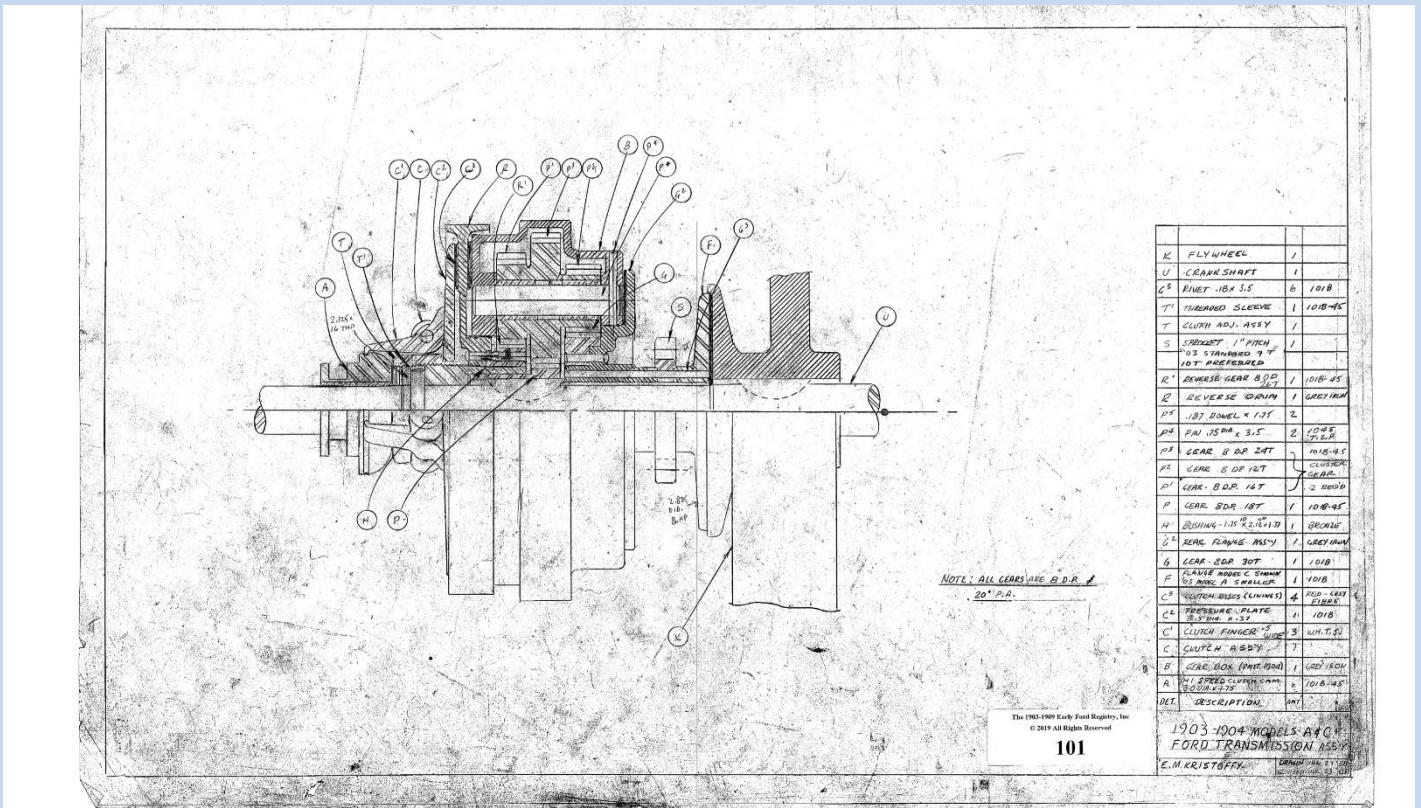

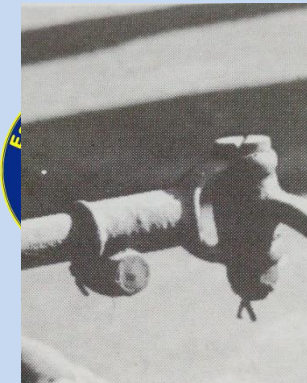

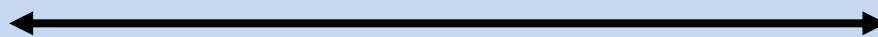
