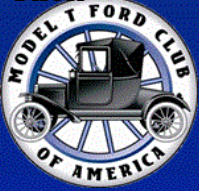

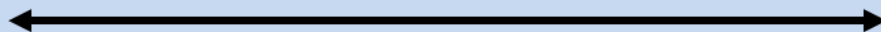

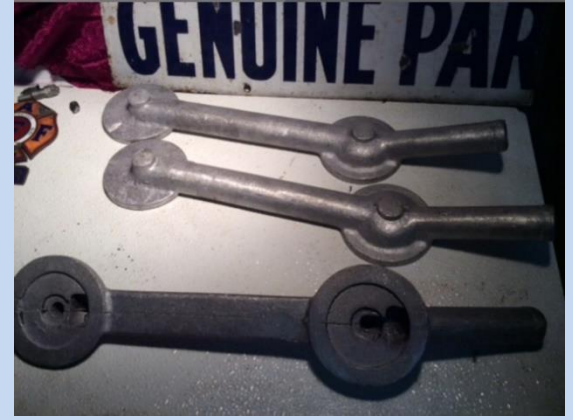

### **Ford NRS Project For Sale**

Complete chassis, frame, axles springs, etc. This is from a 1907 Model S Roadster but could form the basis of an N, R, or S as well. The excellent frame has been restored, front crossmember repaired and is complete with inner reinforcement and spring bracket and as well the rear crossmember straightened. These crossmembers have not been riveted and are bolted at present. Front axle will require minor straightening and one stub axle has been fabricated from a Model T unit. The rear housings are great, but the bearings are rusty. The driveshaft is seized but complete. The engine is a starting point, but another unit would be preferred. The transmission frame is poor but there is the better part of two units. The components are available new. No fasteners, small hardware included. Specific pictures can be provided. The asking price is \$6200.
