We have had thousands of photos from members showing their cars, tours and swap meets for many years. **John Biggs, Past President EFR2**, has forwarded many new items including videos.

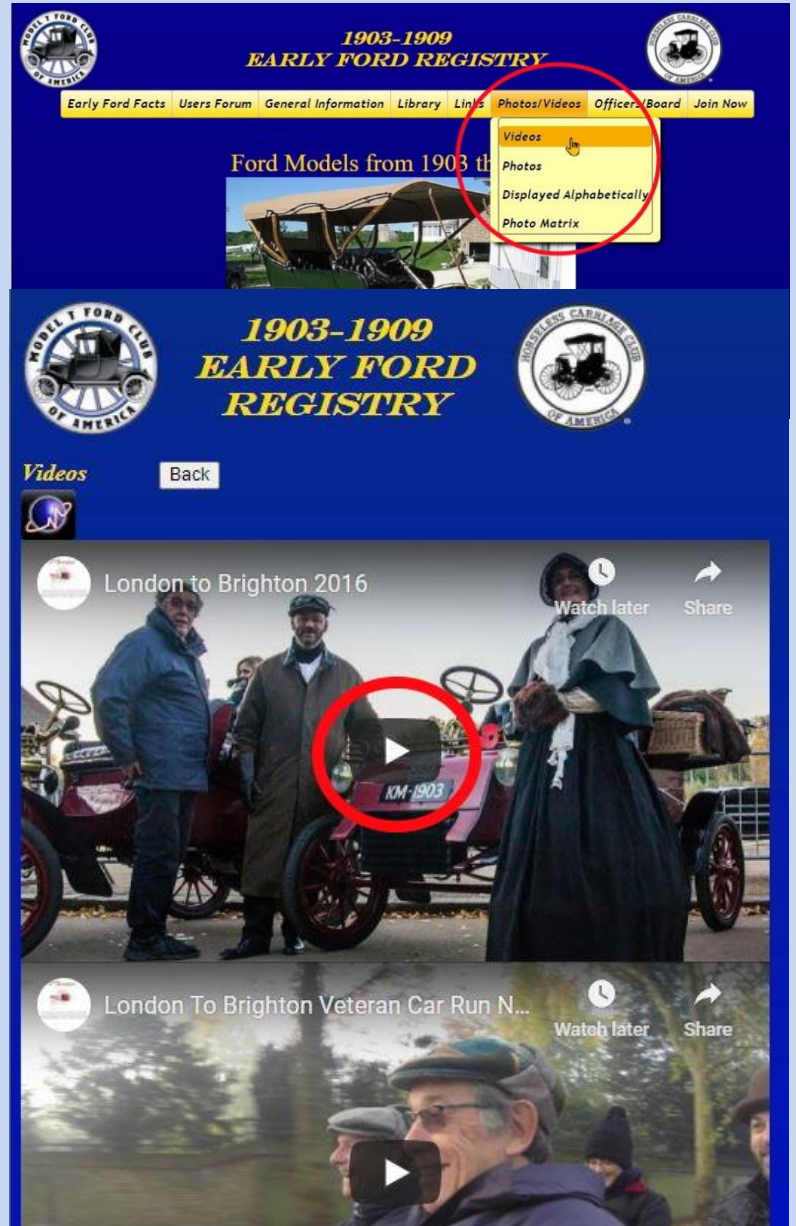

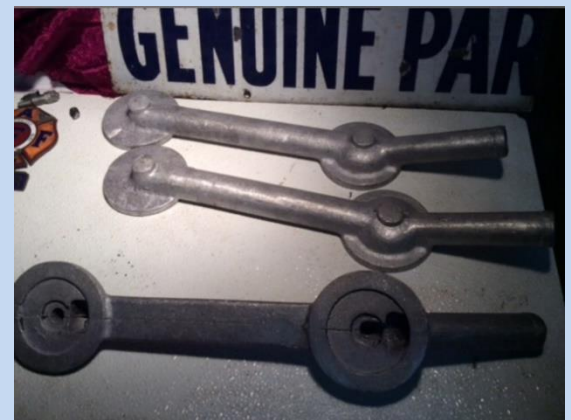
