The **1903-1909 Early Ford Registry, Inc** (EFR) has been selected by George DeAngelis' survivors to receive the late George DeAngelis research papers, notes, drawings, photos and films of his work documenting Henry Ford's first automobile, the Quadricycle.

We believe this treasure of history should be made available to the world. Any current member of the EFR may access, peruse, copy, print and use this information with no charge. No person or group of persons may charge for using the information. The ownership remains with the EFR.

To become a member of the EFR simply go to the EFR web page and complete the on-line registration under the "How to Join" tab. You may pay your annual dues of \$15 by PayPal on the same tab. You do not need to be a member of PayPal to use the service. The EFR web page is www.EarlyFordRegistry.com. When your application is processed, you will be issued an EFR login.

To access the complete library of information, we require you to "sign-in" to the library using your email address. We will use this information to analyze interest in the information. Your external IP address will also be sent to the office to ward off hackers and spammers. This address used to identify your internet connection.

When you choose "*The George DeAngelis Memorial Library*" from the Library tab, you will need to enter your EFR Login - the same as you do when reading the Newsletters. Your login is your last name in lower case and EFR Number - No spaces. For Example: Ima A. McDonald Jr. with Early Ford Registry member number 23 would be - - - mcdonald23.
